**INSTRUCTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR ALL THE TEST TAKERS ON
MARCH 13, 2021**

IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT THE TEST TAKERS REFLECT ON THESE
QUESTIONS BEFORE ARRIVING AT THE TEST CENTER:

- In the past 14 days, you have not come into close contact (within 6 feet) with someone who has a positive covid-19 test or is presumed to have covid-19.
- You do not have covid-19 or reason to believe you have covid-19. Symptoms of covid-19 include cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell.
- To your knowledge, you are not violating any travel restrictions or quarantining requirements.
- You agree to wear a mask the entire time you're at this test site and follow instructions from testing staff.
- We have taken measures to help create a safe testing environment; however, it isn't possible to entirely remove the risk of covid-19 exposure. By entering the testing room, you're accepting that risk.



- ✓ **ALTHOUGH THE COLLEGE BOARD HAS MADE THE EXEMPTION FROM THE ADMISSION TICKET ON THE TEST DAY, YET WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND YOU ALL TO BRING THE TICKET IN ORDER TO AVOID ANY LAST-MINUTE ADMISSION ISSUES.**
- ✓ **ALL MOBILE PHONES WILL BE COLLECTED FROM THE STUDENTS AT THE CHECKIN POINT 1 ITSELF.**
- ✓ All students are required to show their ID each time they reenter the testing room during a scheduled or unscheduled break. Students should keep their printed admission ticket with them at all times.
- ✓ Any Test taker switching from taking SAT to SAT with Essay or vice versa, must inform the same at Check Point 1 and Check point 2 positively. Once the room is allocated, there will be no scope of changing the room.
- ✓ As with all administrations, only test materials can be on a student's desk during testing. Sanitizer, extra masks, or other COVID 19 related supplies must be under their desks.
- ✓ **Please be notified that the breaks between the exams have been extended, hence the dispersal of the test takers will also be affected apparently.**
- ✓ Students must pull their masks down during center and room check-in, pulling them away from their face for visual inspection.
- ✓ Students need to place ID and admission ticket faceup on the admission table/proctor's desk, so that the documents can be examined without picking them up.
- ✓ Students can place their devices or bagged items in the designated place rights at Checkpoint Entry 1, and collect them before leaving the campus. Test takers must ensure that the bags are labeled with the proper names.
- ✓ **Test takers will not be allowed to carry any devices beyond the Checkpoint Entry 1, however, water bottles, snacks, desired stationery, calculator, preventive stuff are allowed.**
- ✓ **After the test is over, the test takers must move out of the campus without any delay, as sitting and waiting in the waiting arena is strictly prohibited for the March Admin.**
