



THE DIGITAL SAT GUIDELINES

REPORTING TIME: 7:00 AM TO 7:30 AM

TENTATIVE DEPARTURE TIME: 12 NOON

Students must present either a valid passport with their name, photograph, and signature, or a valid Aadhaar PVC Card with their name and photograph. Only the letter and PVC Card forms of Aadhaar ID are valid. The letter must be the hard copy as issued by the government of India in its original form (printouts, copies, screen shots, or e-cards are not acceptable). The only exception to this policy is a U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) Common Access Card (CAC), which may be used instead of a passport.

Student Devices

- Student will use school-managed or their own device
 - Windows or Mac laptop
 - Windows tablet or iPad
 - School-managed Chromebook
 - **Personal Chromebooks are not allowed.**
- Devices should be fully charged
- Device setup
 - Load Bluebook testing app

1 If a student who does not attend your institution brought a school-managed device and is unable to download the testing app, send them to the help room.

Device Requirements

- **All test takers must get their own devices, as our center will not provide devices to any students.**
- **The Testing duration is 2 hours, with a break in between the 2 sections. However, this does not include the break time, instruction time, and any unforeseen situation which could involve time.**

Tech Readiness

- Download Bluebook to the device you're going to test with.
- Then 1–5 days before your test, you'll complete a quick exam setup. (The application will confirm that your device meets all requirements)
- Then it will download your test and generate your admission ticket.
- **Note:** You can print your admission ticket or email it to yourself, so you have it handy on test day.

How do I print my digital SAT admission ticket?

- If you've registered for an upcoming digital SAT administration, five days before your test date you'll see your registration listed on the [Bluebook™ homepage](#). You'll need to complete exam set up, then the app will generate your admission ticket. From the screen in Bluebook, you can either email the ticket to yourself to present on your phone during check-in or print it to bring on test day.

What to Bring on Digital SAT Test Day

- Your fully charged testing device with the Bluebook™ application installed ([see detailed device requirements](#)).
- Face covering (if required at your test center).
- Your up-to-date admission ticket.
- Acceptable photo ID.
- Pencils or pens for scratch work.
- An acceptable calculator for use on the Math section of the test (there will be an embedded calculator available to use within Bluebook).

All test takers must present the hard copies of the valid verification documents, hence no soft copies will be entertained.

Your saviours.....

- A watch without an audible alarm (The Bluebook application has a built-in timer that tells you exactly how much time you have left, but you might still want to time your break.)
- A charging cable, if your testing device can't hold a charge for 3 hours.
- A bag or backpack (can be kept outside the testing room)
- A drink or snacks (for your break)

Digital SAT ID Requirements

- *Test center staff will compare the information on your admission ticket and your photo ID with the test center roster to confirm your registration and identity. You can't be admitted to the test center if any of the information doesn't match. For example, you can't use a nickname on one item but your full name on another.*
- *The staff isn't required to hold your seat or wait to begin testing if you didn't bring acceptable (physical and valid) identification and need to go home and return with ID.*

ID Checklist - ID documents must meet all of these requirements:

- Be a valid (unexpired) photo ID that is government issued. **Aadhar card or valid Passport in our case.**
- Be an original, physical document (not photocopied or electronic).
- Bear your full, legal name exactly as it appears on your admission ticket, including the order of the names.
- Bear a recent recognizable photograph that clearly matches both your appearance on test day and the photo you provided when you registered.
- Be in good condition, with clearly legible English language text and a clearly visible photograph.

1. **Students must bring their own devices-** Windows or Mac Laptop, Tab or iPad. The center does not hold any responsibility for the any students without the devices.
2. **Personal Chromebooks are not allowed**
3. Devices must be fully charged, with at least 3 hours battery backup
4. Downloaded and installed **latest/ updated** bluebook testing app

- a. iPad OS- 13.4 or later
- b. iPad PRO
- c. iPad Air2 or later
- d. iPad 5th generation or later
- e. iPad Mini 4 or later
